Purpose

As professional foresters, it is critical that you stay up-to-date on the latest regulations that impact the logging industry. The WV Division of Forestry (WVDOF) is mandated under the WV Logging Sediment Control Act (LSCA) to provide educational opportunities for loggers on how to stay in compliance with this law.

While you may have attended the WVDOF BMP classes in the past, with the recent changes in the BMP requirements, this workshop will provide attendees a one-on-one opportunity to discuss issues and concerns with the WVDOF personnel and hear the latest available information on:

- Protocol for timber licensing and notification
- Proper use of BMPs
- Planning a timber harvest

Any professional forester, forestry technician or field person whose job responsibilities involve compliance with the WV Logging Sediment Control Act.
