The "Hands On" Teachers Workshop is sponsored by the WV Conservation Education Council (WVCEC), with partial funding provided by Georgia-Pacific. This workshop is intended to increase the knowledge and appreciation for our natural resources, specifically the interrelationship of forest and wildlife management. The workshop will provide knowledge and resource materials to all K-12 educators, as well as adult educators. The workshop includes programs by the WV Division of Forestry, WV Division of Natural Resources, WV Conservation Agency, the Ruffed Grouse Society, and others. Information on various conservation education programs, including Project Learning Tree (PLT), will be included in the workshop. The workshop runs from 8:00am - 4:00pm each day, with time split between classroom sessions and field trips.
