WVU Medicine Children's – the state's only Children's Miracle Network Hospital – has, over the fast year, served more than 70,000 unique patients across West Virginia, eastern Maryland and Southwestern Pennsylvania. Proceeds from our Log Auctions have been committed to helping WVU Medicine Children's build a new hospital. We will be following local, state, and federal restrictions for COVID-19. Social distancing and mask wearing will be required at all times during auction proceedings.

Following are options for making contributions. For your convenience and in order for appropriate arrangements to be made by the planners, accompanying this letter is a form that we request be used for making a contribution.

A contribution of pulpwood or peelers can be made as a Phantom Load, sold unseen at the auction and delivered by the contributor directly from the logging site to the purchasing mill following the auction. **Or**, a load of pulpwood or peelers can be delivered the day of the auction, sold on the truck, and delivered to the purchaser later that same day.

- Deliveries of sawlogs can be made the Tuesday and Wednesday prior to the sale. They
 will be scaled, graded, and a fair market value determined, unless the contributor
 provides this information on the accompanying form. The products will then be sold at
 the auction.

- Arrangements have also been made with Weyerhaeuser Company that will allow
 contributors to deliver loads of either peelers to Buckhannon or pulpwood to Flatwoods
 and have the payment made directly to the Log-a-Load for Kids campaign on behalf of
 the contributor or have the payment split between the contributor and Log-a-Load for
 Kids in any percentage determined by the contributor. If either of these options is
 used, the contributor is asked to contact Mark Shreve at 304-203-5647 immediately
 after the load is delivered and provide him with a ticket number so the appropriate
 payments can be made.
- If you cannot make a contribution of logs or other roundwood products, please consider a donation of another item for the auction. In the past, we've received and sold items such as firewood, rustic fencing, flooring, wood pellets, log coating and equipment, skidder tire chains, WVU sports memorabilia, portable generators, and finished furniture, to name only a few.
